2020 Innovision Society Scholarships

\$5,000 scholarships offered to help unlock brighter futures for deserving and dedicated students.

Applicant must be 24 years of age or younger at time of application. Selection will be made without regard to applicant's race, color, ethnic origin, religious beliefs, sex, marital status or physical ability. Applications will be scored by the Innovision Society's scholarship committee based on GPA, SAT or equivalent, essay (grammar and content will be graded), community involvement, awards, achievements and government/student relations (Belva Roberts scholarship only). Transcripts are required. Essay and application must be written in English. Applications must be received by March 1, 2020. Innovision Society Scholarship winners will be announced on or around May 31, 2020. Funds will be paid directly to the winners' college/university on or around August 31, 2020. Applicant agrees to accept the decisions of the Innovision Society as final. Past Innovision Society Scholarship winners and CCSSM winners, volunteers, and their immediate family members are not eligible. Interested applicants are encouraged to apply for both scholarships; however, only one scholarship per applicant will be awarded. Innovision Society and each of its officers, directors, employees, members, representatives and volunteers will in no way be responsible for claims of damages or losses of any kind including direct, indirect, incidental, consequential or punitive damages arising out of applicant's participation in the Scholarship Program, nor any damages arising from accessing or downloading from and/or printing material downloaded from the website. Applications will be scored by a scholarship committee based on the following criteria:

GPA*	15%
SAT or equivalent*	5%
Community Involvement	10%
Government/Student Relations	20%
Essay	30%
Financial Need	20%

Here's How:

Submit a written essay (minimum 1,000 words). Interested applicants are encouraged to apply for both scholarships; however, only one scholarship per applicant will be awarded.

Eligibility

- 24 years of age or younger at the time of application.
- Must be applying to be a full-time student, at an accredited college or university, **OR** a full-time student attending and continuing at an accredited college or university.
- Preference will be given to students with demonstrated financial need.
- \$10 membership fee.
- Proof of enrollment or acceptance at an accredited college or university will be required if selected.
- For the Innovision Society's Belva Roberts Leadership Scholarship, all of the above criteria is required to be eligible; in addition to having an interest in leadership and government relations and/or student relations.
